Most sediment barriers on the market must be replaced and are then discarded when they lose their effectiveness. This occurs numerous times throughout the year. Many of these products also absorb¹ contaminants making them potentially hazardous and difficult to dispose of. As the manufacturer of **The Heavyweight Wattle™**, World Textile and Bag, Inc. is providing alternatives to these environmental issues.

- 1) Reuse:** **The Heavyweight Wattle™** was designed to last multiple years on active construction sites while still maintaining its effectiveness. The durability virtually eliminates the need to replace sediment barriers during the year and allows for re-installation and reuse at other sites. We have been told that the majority of our customers are moving our product to other sites rather than disposing of it. A common environmental slogan is “**Reuse is the highest form of Recycling!**”
- 2) Recondition:** World Textile and Bag, Inc. will recondition all usable product² for resale at a reduced price that is returned³ to our Richmond warehouse.
- 3) Recycle:** If **The Heavyweight Wattle™** is not in a condition to recondition we will separate and recycle the components returned³ to our factory location. The raw materials⁴ used in the construction of **The Heavyweight Wattle™** are all 100% recyclable.
